ORDINANCE NO. 1595

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE
OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE
VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTY, ILLINOIS"

WHEREAS, by a majority vote of the corporate authorities now holding office, the corporate authorities of the Village of Channahon ("Village") have determined that the personal property described in this Ordinance is no longer necessary or useful to the Village, and;

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have determined that it is in the best interests to sell said property through a newspaper advertisement in the Joliet Herald News.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON, WILL AND GRUNDY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AUTHORIZATION TO SELL Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the personal property described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Channahon and the best interests of the Village of Channahon will be served by its sale.

Therefore, the Village Administrator be and hereby authorized to take all steps reasonable and necessary to effect the sale of the personal property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto through a newspaper advertisement in the Joliet Herald News requesting sealed bids to the highest bidder on said property.

Section 2: ADVERTISEMENT The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to and may direct the Joliet Herald News to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal property in a newspaper published within the community.

Section 3: AGREEMENT OF SALE The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the successful bidder for the sale of said personal property. The Village has the right to reject any and/or all bids.


Section 4: TRANSFER OF TITLE Upon payment to the Village, The Village Administrator and/or the Village President are hereby authorized and directed to convey and transfer title to aforesaid personal property to the successful bidder.

Section 5: REPEALER: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6 SEVERABILITY: This Ordinance and every provision thereof, Shall be considered severable. In the event that any court of competent jurisdiction may find and declare any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section or part of a phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision or section of this Ordinance is void or unconstitutional, the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, provisions or sections not ruled void or unconstitutional shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 7: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.

PASSED this 2nd day of November, 2009, with 6 members voting aye, 0 members voting nay, 0 members abstaining, and with 0 members absent, the President not voting; said vote being: McMillin aye, Greco aye, Nash aye, Militello aye, Papesh aye, Slocum aye, and Cook not voting.


