

You are invited to attend a Public Hearing held by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) concerning the improvement at I-55 at US 6 (Eames Street). The study area along US 6 begins just west of the interchange of I-55 and US 6 and extends to the east for a distance of approximately one mile within the Channahon Village limits. The project includes the reconstruction of US 6 to provide two lanes in each direction with a curbed median as well as intersection improvements, relocation of the frontage roads in the northwest, northeast and southeast quadrants, and pedestrian and bicyclist accommodations.
