Proposed Improvement This work shall consist of crack 11,844 square yards of asphalt surface cleaning/preparation, application of Class A-2 bituminous surface treatment, and construction of aggregate wedge shoulder.

2. IDOT prequalification is required. Prequalification Certificate must be received before the bid opening or included with the bid. The 2 low bidders must file with the Awarding Authority within 24 hours after the letting an "Affidavit of Availability" (Form BC 57), showing all uncompleted contracts awarded to them and all low bids pending award for Federal, State, County, Municipal and private work.
3. All proposals must be accompanied by a proposal guaranty as provided in BLRS Special Provision for Bidding Requirements and Conditions for Contract Proposals contained in the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions".
4. The Awarding Authority reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals as provided in BLRS Special Provision for Bidding Requirements and Conditions for Contract Proposals contained in the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions".
5. Bidders need not return the entire contract proposal when bids are submitted unless otherwise required. Portions of the proposal that must be returned include the following:
a. BLR 12210 - Contract Cover
b. BLR 12220 - Notice to Bidders
c. BLR 12221 - Contract Proposal
d. BLR 12222 - Contract Schedule of Prices
e. BLR 12223 - Signatures
f. BLR 12230 - Proposal Bid Bond (if applicable)
g. BLR 12325 - Apprenticeship or Training Program Certification (do not use for federally funded projects)
6. The quantities appearing in the bid schedule are approximate and are prepared for the comparison of bids. Payment to the Contractor will be made only for the actual quantities of work performed and accepted or materials furnished according to the contract. The scheduled quantities of work to be done and materials to be furnished may be increased, decreased or omitted as hereinafter provided.

7. Submission of a bid shall be conclusive assurance and warranty the bidder has examined the plans and understands all requirements for the performance of work. The bidder will be responsible for all errors in the proposal resulting from failure or neglect to conduct an in depth examination. The Awarding Authority will, in no case be responsible for any costs, expenses, losses or changes in anticipated profits resulting from such failure or neglect of the bidder.
8. The bidder shall take no advantage of any error or omission in the proposal and advertised contract.
9. Bids are to be addressed to the Village of Channahon and shall be marked "Sealed Bid – 2013 Bituminous Surface Treatment A-2 Project". When sent by mail, the sealed proposal shall be addressed to the Awarding Authority at the address and in care of the official in whose office the bids are to be received. All proposals shall be filed prior to the time and at the place specified in the Notice to Bidders. Proposals received after the time specified will be returned to the bidder unopened.
10. Permission will be given to a bidder to withdraw a proposal if the bidder makes the request in writing or in person before the time for opening proposals.
11. Contractors will be required to comply with all laws, including those relating to the employment of labor and the payment of the general prevailing rate of hourly wages in the locality in which the work is to be performed for each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to execute the contract or perform such work, also the general prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work (including, but not necessarily limited to 820 ILCS 103/0.01 et seq. the "Prevailing Wage Act") as ascertained by the Illinois Department of Labor for Will and Grundy Counties, Illinois shall be paid for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract or to perform such work. The Bidder shall require all subcontractors (if any) to conform with said laws, and any rules or regulations now and thereafter issued pursuant to said laws by Bidder, his subcontractors, and/or anyone working through or on behalf of Bidder or Bidder's subcontractors. For projects in excess of \$50,000, certification of participation in apprenticeship and training programs approved and registered with the United States Department of Labor's Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training is required.
