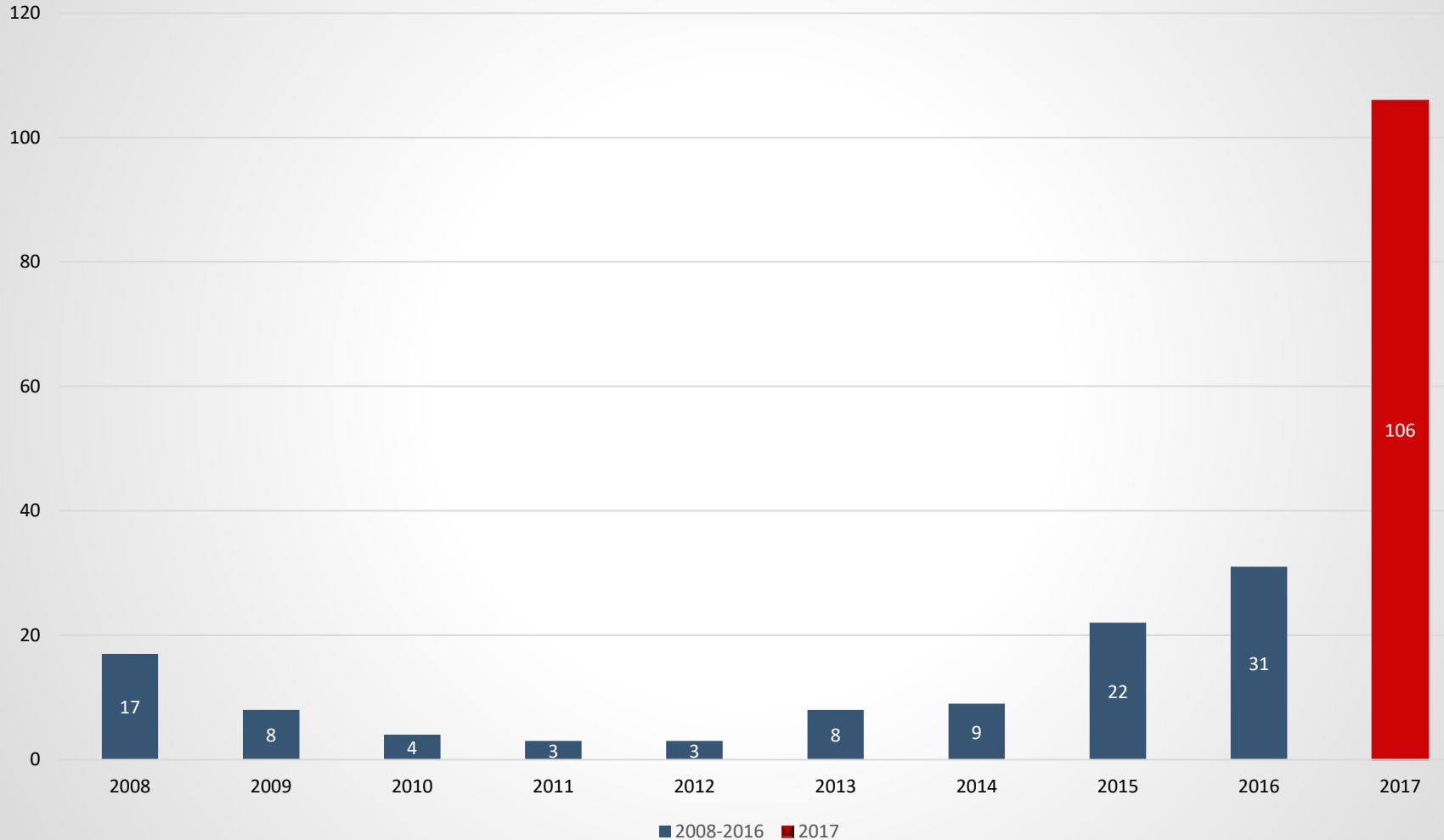

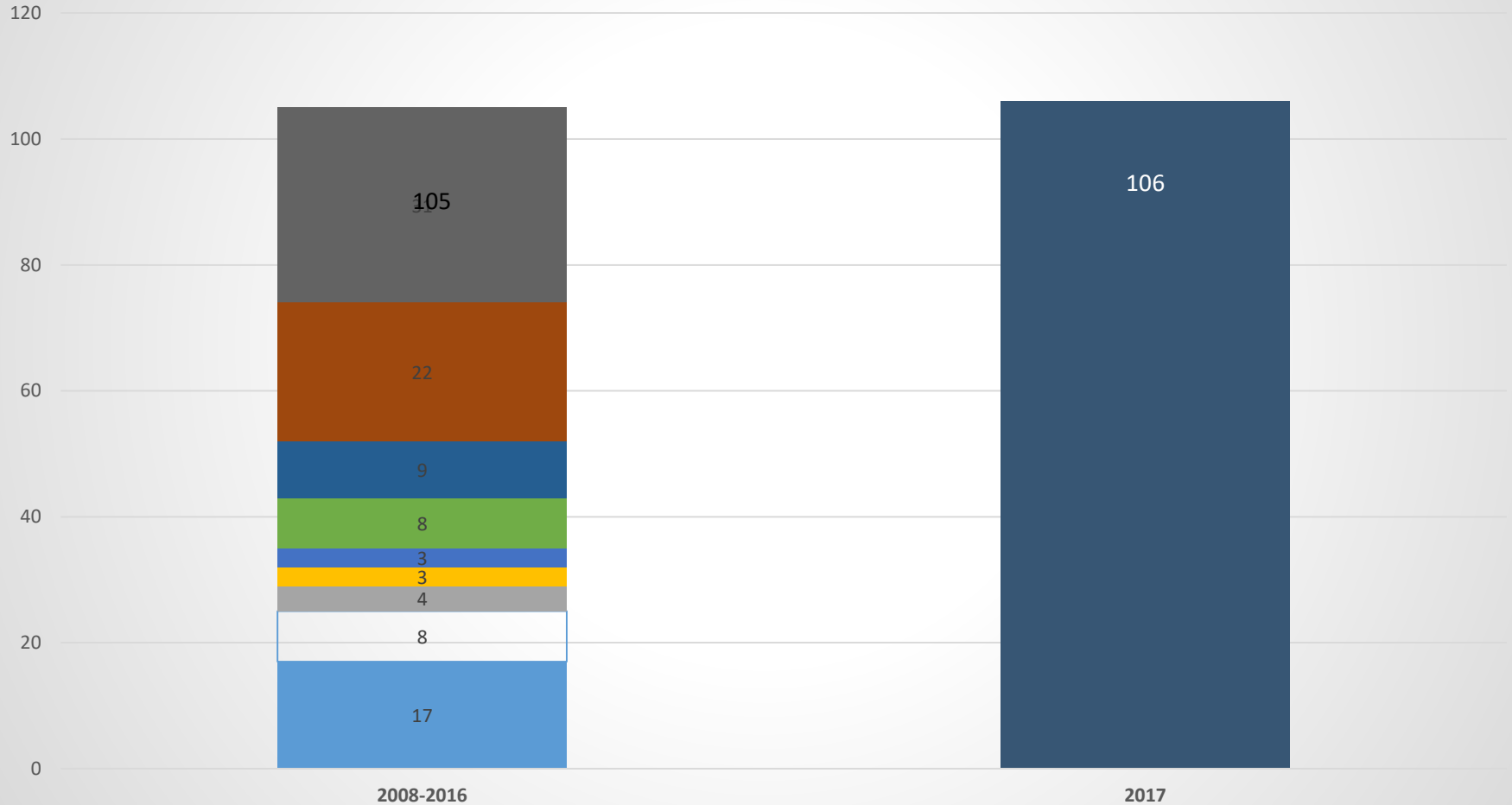

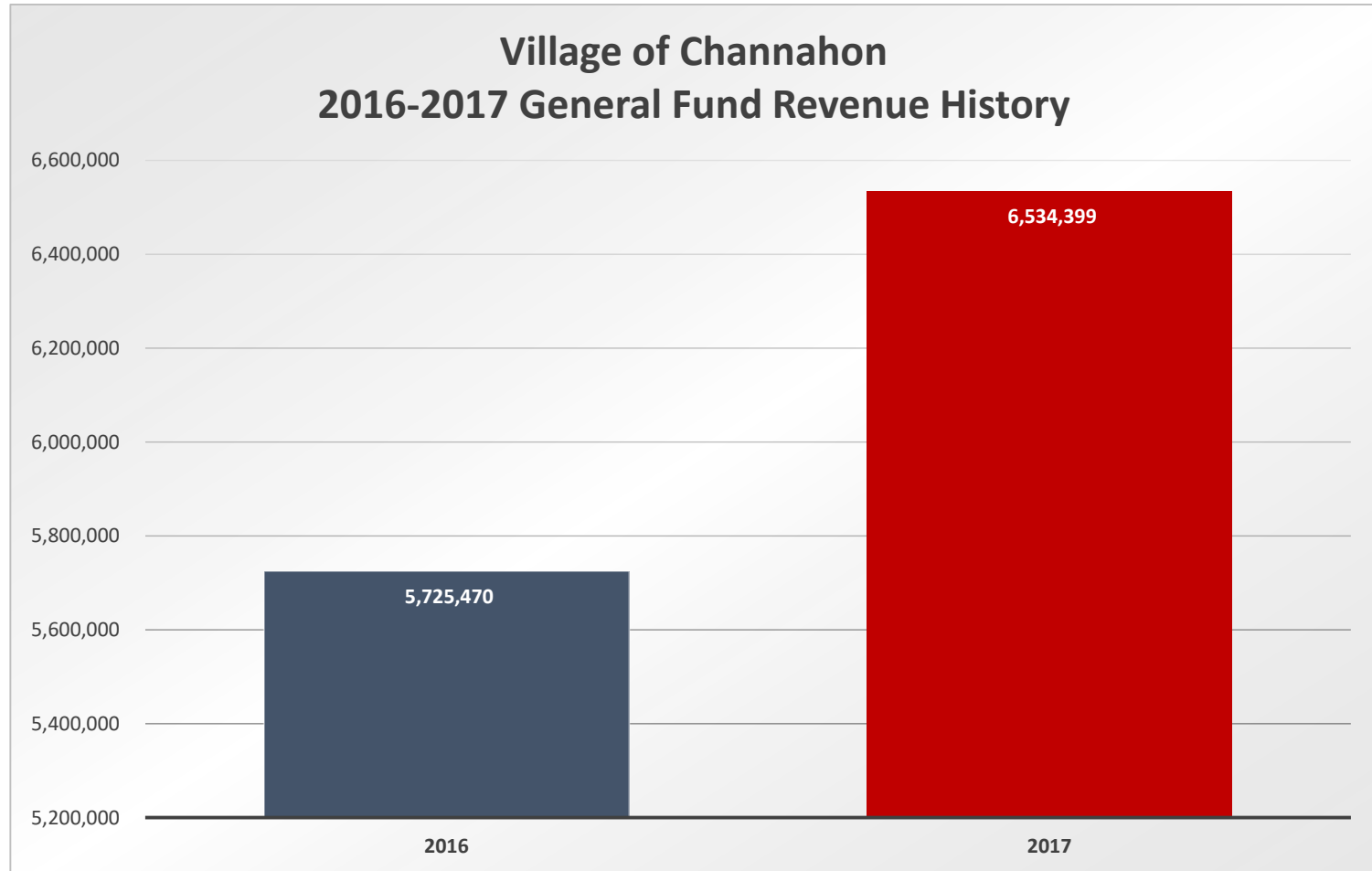

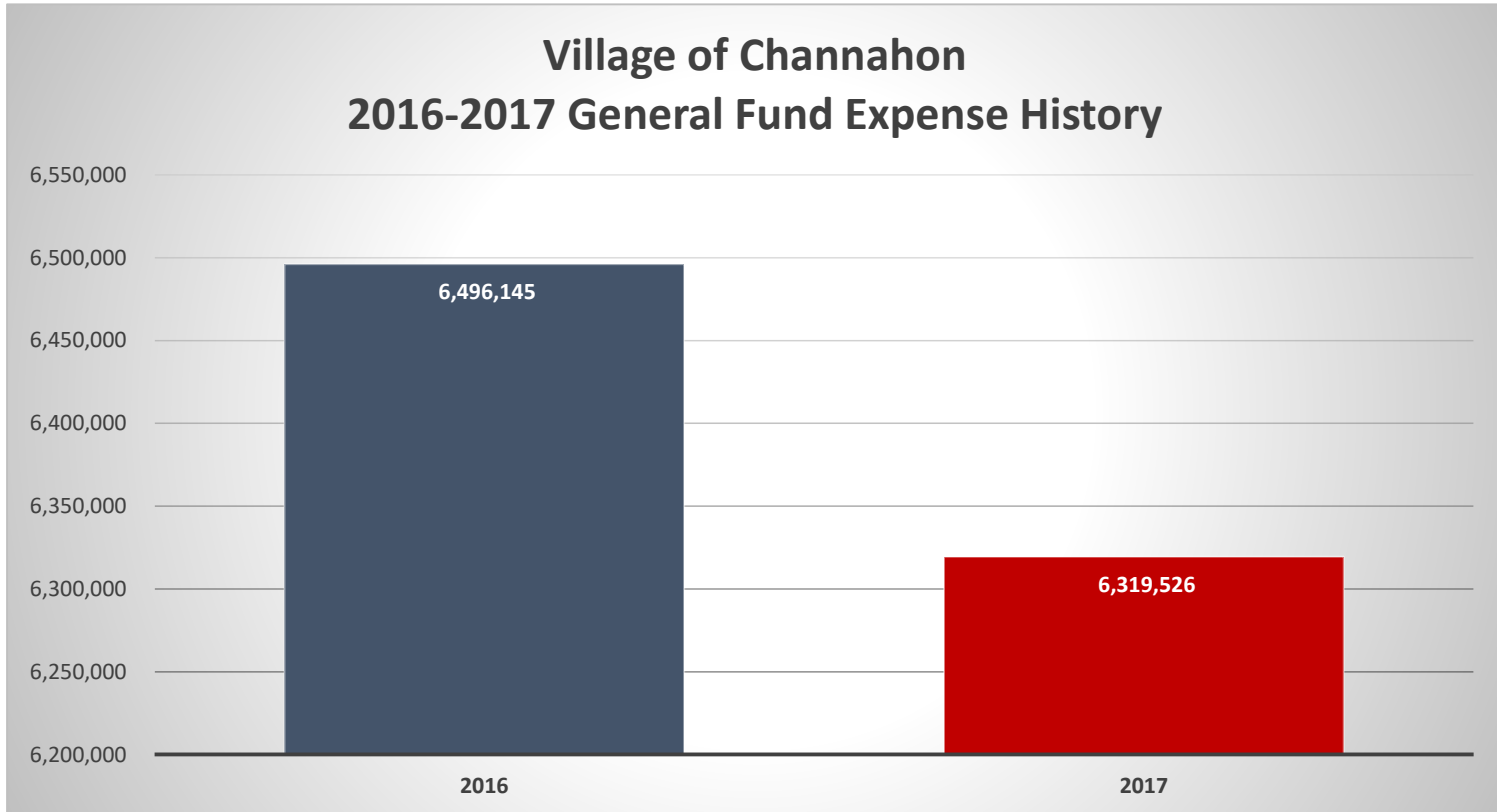

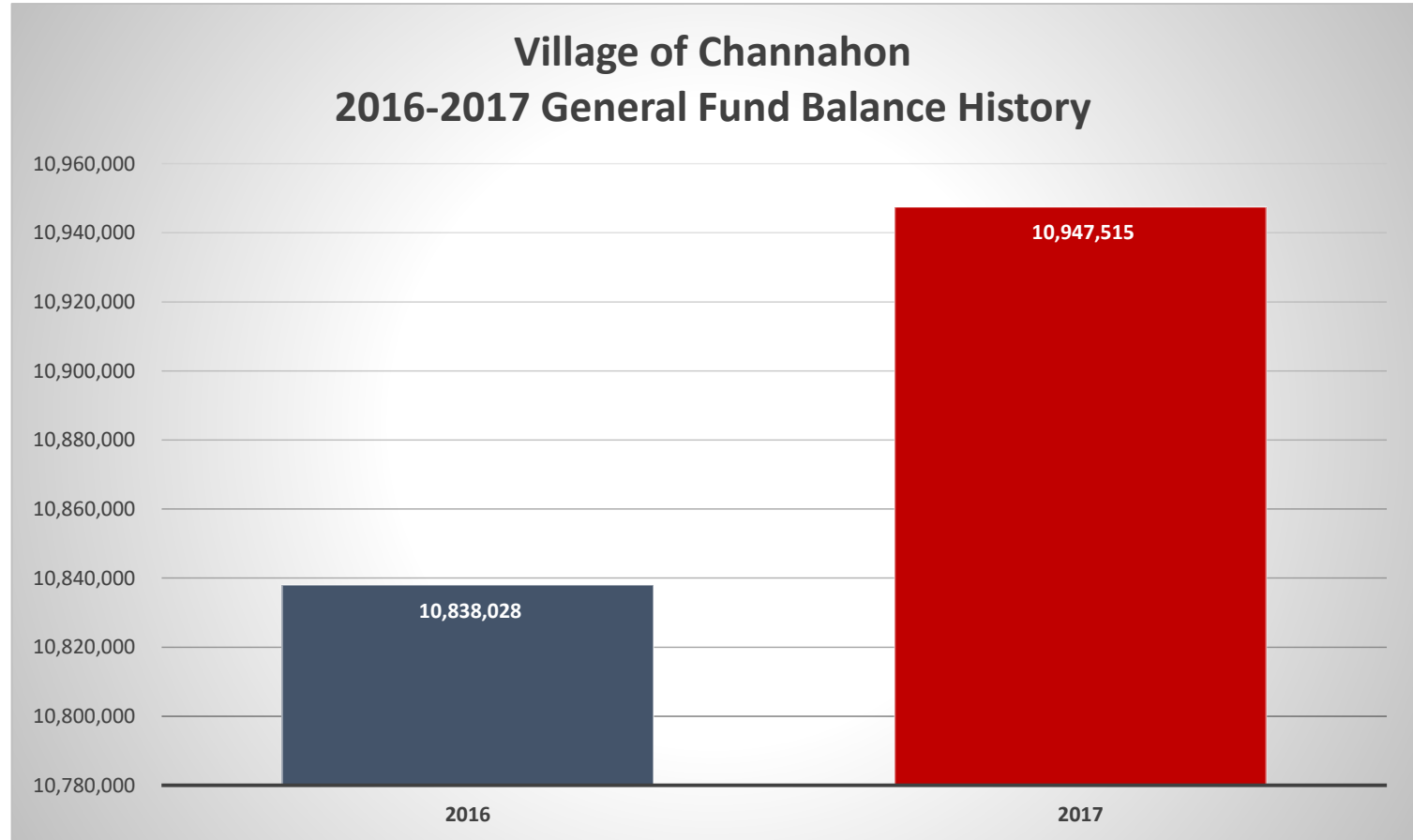
# VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON 2016-2017 REVENUE HISTORY



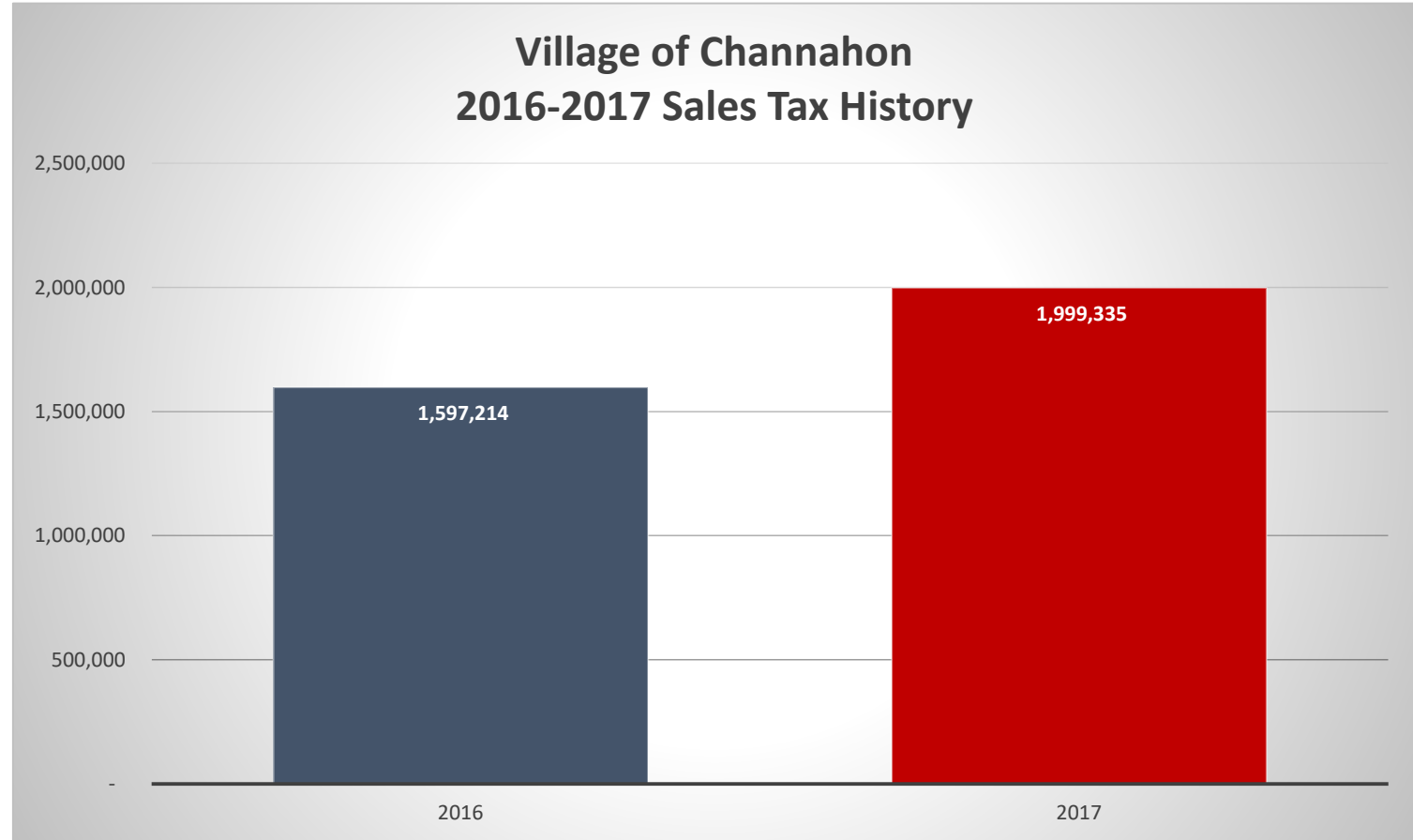
# VILLAGE OF CHANNAHON 2016-2017 GENERAL FUND EXPENSE HISTORY

# PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT



## **ED DOLEZAL**

*Director of Public Works*

The Public Works Department consists of three general areas of responsibility. They are the street, utility and GIS/IS divisions.

✓ **GOAL: Expand plant from .72 million gallons per day to 1.43 MGD. The construction is estimated to cost \$8.6 million.**

✓ The expansion project will also give us the ability to:  
Remove phosphorous and enhance our ability to remove nitrogen



# WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION

Public Works Engineering annually evaluates all Village roadways and applies a road condition rating of between 1 and 10:

- ✓ The Village currently maintains 82.2 centerline miles of roadway, an increase of 4.6% from 2016 and 39.2% since 2010 (59.05 CL-M).
- ✓ The overall road condition rating as of the end of 2016 is 6.63.

- ✓ Projected Budget = \$851,900

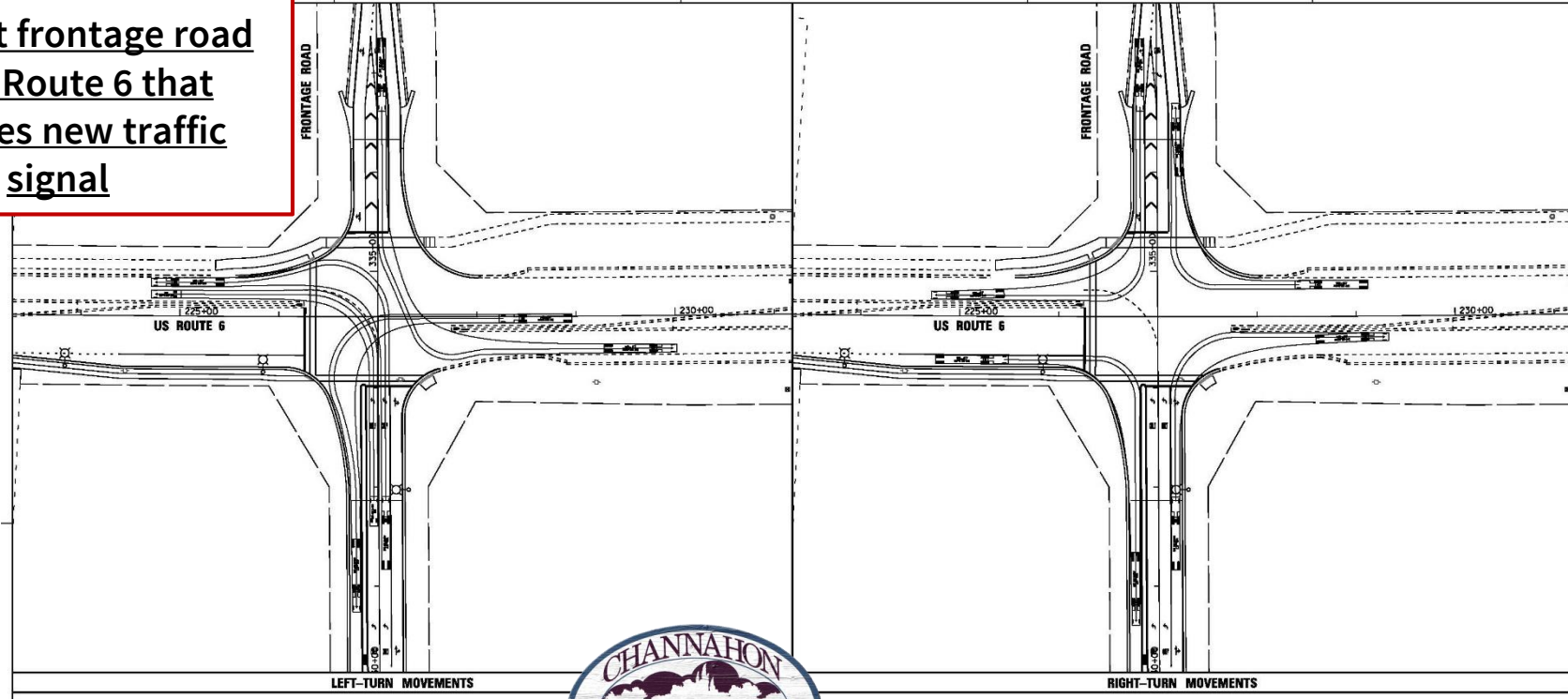
