



The following is taken from the Channahon Code of Ordinances. The complete Code of Ordinances can be found on the website - www.channahon.org.

Class D - Outing Permits

Class D licenses shall authorize the sale or distribution of alcoholic liquors at the place specified in the application for picnics or other public outings for periods not to exceed one day. The fee for a class D license shall be \$50 for each day the license is in effect. Said fee shall be waived twice per calendar year for any unit of government and for any not for profit corporation whose principal address is within the Village. A series of fund-raising events with the same common theme shall be considered one waiver for the entire series.

Hours of Operation

No licensee shall keep open or allow his place of business to remain open or sell or offer for sale at retail, or offer to give away on any licensed premises, any alcoholic liquor in the Village during the following hours:
